

Harry Potter Scarf

Quick and Easy

Material:

- 200g of golden, aran weight yarn
- 200g of crimson, aran weight yarn
- 5.5mm needles
- Tapestry needle

Instructions:

Cast on 30 stitches in the dark red /crimson color (or the desired width of your scarf) and work in simple rib stitch (k1, p1) until you have knitted half the width of the scarf. This is approximately 20-24 rows if you casted on 30 stitches. Change color to the yellow / golden yarn and repeat until you have 8 yellow sections and 9 red sections.

Cast off and make tassels to attach to the end. It is easiest to wrap the yarn around a 18 cm long piece of cardboard 14 times and cut it at one end. Using a crochet hook, drag the yarn through a stitch in the scarf and secure (see picture). To match the scarf from the first movie you should have an odd number of tassels, starting and ending with red.



You can make the scarf any dimensions that you wish but this is based on the yarn that I had at home. Some patterns suggest that the scarf in the movies have 9 sections of yellow and 10 sections of red and 4 yellow and 5 red tassels at each end. Just remember that you will need some more yarn to do this. What makes this scarf quick and easy is the rib stitching as it doesn't give a right or a wrong side and makes the scarf pretty warm and cozy without having to work on circular needles.
